			Depending on their properties, objects can bend, stretch, squash and twist.	
8	translucen t	Translucent means you can see some light through it, but not everything. It is not completely clear.	Objects materials are decided based on their properties. For example, a window is made of glass because it is hardwearing, you can see through it (transparent) and it lets light through. Doors are made of wood because it is strong and rigid. Toys are made of plastic because it comes in lots of colours, and it is hardwearing.
