Dear Parents and Carers,

As our Call of the Wild residential is fast approaching, we would like to provide you with some key information.

Registration

On the morning of the trip, we will aim to leave Red Hill Field at 8 am, so we would ask that the children **arrive at school by 7.30 am**. Children can bring their luggage to the Year 6 classroom and then stay there to register. If you are waiting to wave goodbye to your child, then please wait on the KS2 playground.

<u>Medication</u>

Please ensure that any medication is passed over to **Mrs Wilkinson**, who will be on the playground, along with any instructions and further information about the administration of that medication. If there is any new or additional information you wish to pass on to us, please do not wait until the morning of the trip as it will be very busy.

Packed lunch

Please provide your child with a packed lunch and a water bottle for the first day – food would be best stored in a plastic bag so that the rubbish can be thrown in the bin.

Return

On our return, we will leave Wales at lunchtime and will aim to be back at Red Hill Field between 5 and 5.30 pm, depending on the traffic. If there are any significant changes to these times, the office will endeavour to inform parents through our contact system.
